Bible Study

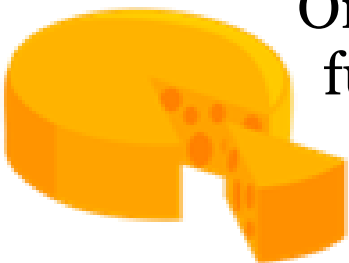
The Bible Study group will take a break over the summer months. The group will start up again on Wednesday, September 16th at 10:00 a.m.
